Welcome to Victoria College

The Foundation was launched in 2002 as part of the 150th anniversary of the opening of Victoria College. It was created to support the ever-changing needs of school life and help sustain the long-held tradition of providing a high-quality education for all. It plays a vital role in fundraising for capital projects that allow the school to continue to expand and enhance its facilities to meet the changing needs of our boys, the school and education in general.

The Foundation is registered as a Jersey Charitable Trust (registration number NPO0882) and is the hub of our alumni and fundraising network. The funds we raise go towards:

- funding bursaries (our priority)
- enhancing our facilities
- supporting our students and staff with additional equipment or activities that enhance their learning (when not covered by the school's budget)
- maintaining the Old Victorian alumni network

In the past, the Foundation has raised funds to refurbish the school's magical, 'Hogwarts-like' Great Hall; build the Le Brocq block of four English classrooms; establish the five House common rooms; and support prizes, including the Citizenship and Co-curricular Awards, and activities which enhance our boys' overall educational experience.

We are perhaps even more proud to be able to make a Victoria College education accessible to Jersey's brightest and most talented boys from all walks of life. Currently, 59 boys across both Victoria College and Victoria College Preparatory School are supported on a range of full to partial bursaries.

We want to keep supporting these bursaries and extend this support to even more Jersey boys and their families. Looking forward, we will launch a capital fundraising campaign to enable the expansion of our bursary support.



More than a school, we are a community

Victoria College continues to thrive as Jersey's oldest States school (established in 1852) in educating the island's brightest and most talented boys.

With the dedication of our teaching and support staff, the Foundation, Board of Governors, association of Old Victorians and parent volunteers – we are a strong community. Together, we prioritise the safety, wellbeing, learning and prospects of our boys. We also cultivate a base for lifelong belonging and a culture of giving back to the community. Many of our Old Victorians come back to volunteer their time and contribute to the school as Foundation Partners, both financially and by sharing their expertise and experience in their chosen careers.

A world of opportunity awaits

From Victoria College to Cape Canaveral

I was so proud to show my sons Victoria College last summer.

Back in 1979, my parents could not afford private school fees, though they wanted me to have the best life opportunities that only a first-class education can provide. They were advised to apply for a bursary for my school fees. This opened the doors to a new world for me and changed the course of my life.



My early years were focused more on football than my studies. I captained the school team, played for Jersey in three Murattis and was the first Victorian to play for the full National Public Schools. Sitting in the locker room with boys from Eton, Winchester and Charterhouse, I thought, not bad for a lad from Troy Court!

I relished my time at Victoria College. I learned to aim high because it was an environment where everyone did that. With direction and support, I buckled down during my A levels, which earned me a full scholarship to Florida Tech*. (**Ranked top 5% of global universities by The Centre for World University Rankings*)

Beyond College, I studied, played football (winning national titles) and later completed my MBA. After a career in architecture, engineering and construction, where I became CEO, I returned ten years ago to my alma mater, to serve in my current role.

Victoria College opened up a world of fantastic opportunities for me and placed a high-quality education within this Jersey boy's reach, for which I'm eternally grateful.

Charles and PwC: Careers that count

I started at VCP in 2007 and graduated from Victoria College in 2018. At College, I was able to strive high academically in both my GCSEs (2A*s and 9 As) and A Levels (Chemistry A*, Maths A* and Economics A). I was also actively involved in the spirit and life of the school – playing hockey for the 1st XI and captaining the 2nd XI, as well as being a school prefect.

After Sixth Form, I was ready to get some hands-on experience in the workplace and to make a move towards independent living. After due consideration PwC was a clear choice for me. I had been told about the opportunities for development – both professional and educational, by both friends and family and was already familiar with PwC from the Careers Events at school.



I joined PwC in the summer of 2018. I am currently an Associate and I am studying the profession with the hope of continuing to pass the exams and becoming a qualified accountant in the near future.

In November I returned to Victoria College with a colleague, to represent PwC at the Careers Fair. It was good to be back and though I've not been gone too long, I was glad to be able to take part and promote one of the many opportunities which the school provides for its students.

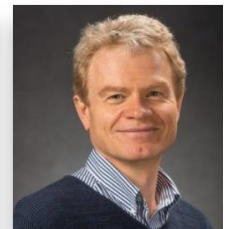
