




# Bursary & Sponsorship Opportunities

# The Victoria College Foundation

The Foundation was launched in 2002 as part of the 150<sup>th</sup> anniversary of the opening of Victoria College.

The Victoria College Foundation is a registered Jersey charity no. 412, and is the hub of our alumni and fundraising network.

It plays a vital role in fund raising to support Victoria College and Victoria College Preparatory School (the “Schools”) to deliver their strategy. This fund raising specifically supports bursaries and scholarships to improve access of able students to the schools, as well as capital projects.

The funds we raise go towards:

- Providing life-changing burasaries to talented boys in need of financial assistance
- Helps establish a permanent endowment for future generations of Old Victorians
- Assists with development of school facilities and resources
- Helps preserve Victoria College’s heritage

In the past, the Foundation has raised funds to build the Le Brocq building, refurbish the Princess Anne Science Block, build the Bistro on the site of the old swimming pool, establish the five House common rooms, refurbish the VCP Gym and the reopening of the Woodland Walks. The Foundation also support prizes, including the Citizenship and Co-curricular Awards, and activities which enhance our boys' overall educational experience.

We are even more proud to be able to make a Victoria College education accessible to aspirational boys from all walks of life.

Currently, 57 boys across both Victoria College and Victoria College Preparatory School are supported on a range of full to partial bursaries.

We want to keep supporting these bursaries and extend this support to even more boys and their families.

There are currently 57 students receiving bursary support at VCJ and VCP and 22 of those are through the Foundation. Funding for our bursaries comes from the Foundation fundraising campaigns, legacies, one-off donations and longstanding agreements with members of the VCJ community.


