

A project to allow students (or members of their family) the opportunity to exhibit and sell a piece of their own artwork at an exhibition in the Great Hall on the evening of **Friday 30th June.**

All types of artworks will be accepted. Any medium, any size, painting, drawing, collage, photography, ceramics, textiles, computer generated design, etc...

The themes for the art are 'my happy place', 'on my mind' and 'creative courage'.

Participation will be recognised via an achievement point, a certificate and inclusion in the next edition of 'The Victorian'.

The two students, whose work receives the highest bid or the highest number of 'public choice' votes, will win a 'studio visit' from a participating artist for themselves and an accompanying adult.

You can frame your work if you'd like for presentation purposes, but it isn't necessary. If you do frame it, the frame will form part of the sale at the event.

By participating, a student confirms that they are happy for their work to be exhibited and sold, with a minimum of 50% of proceeds going towards the future Victoria College Wellbeing garden.

100% of the proceeds from the local artists will be donated to the Victoria College Wellbeing garden.

If you would like to work on your artwork during school time, you can speak to the Art Department about working on your piece at lunchtime during Art Club.

The ArtEquals team will also be running after school workshops during the summer term to help inspire you – keep a look out for the dates and times.

The deadline to hand in your finished artwork to the Business Centre (next to The Temple) is 4pm on Friday 26th May, for the attention of Emily Sweeny.
