Our annual College Sports Day is this year on Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> July. All students participating in Sports Day will travel down to the FB Fields by bus after P1. Please see the letter from Mr. Habin with further details if your son is competing in one of the track and field events on the day.

Students not competing in the Sports Day, will be taking part in our alternative House Tournament Competition in the morning on the school site. This will involve a number of fun and challenging activities, such as Battle Archery, Pétanque and Ultimate Frisbee.

Students will then travel down by bus to FB Fields at either 12.45pm or 1.05pm depending on their year group to watch the track events and support their Houses. To allow for this, lunchtime will start at 12.20pm. Unfortunately, there will be no access to the Bistro so please ensure your son is provided with a packed lunch on the day.

Your son will be dismissed from FB Fields at the conclusion of Sports Day.
