Human Papillomavirus (HPV) Vaccination

The vaccine that protects against infection from the Human Papillomavirus (HPV) which can lead to a range of cancers in later life is being offered to your child at school. Only a single dose of vaccine is required for protection and the dates of the school sessions is set out below.

Please discuss this with your child then complete the e-consent form link below before the vaccination is due, even if you wish to decline the vaccination.

If you do **not** wish your child to receive this vaccination, be assured that once we receive your refusal via the link above we will not vaccinate your child.

If your child misses the vaccine in school, there will be a catch-up clinic held in the Outpatient's Department in Jersey General Hospital on **Thursday 26th February 4pm-7pm** which your child can attend, no appointment is required.
