Dear Parents,

Our Board of Governors works to provide governance, advice and support to both Victoria College and Victoria College Preparatory School to ensure that both our schools offer the best possible educational experience for our students. The Board comprises a mix of Invited Governors, Staff Governors and Parent Governors, with the schools having an allocation of two Parent Governors each. Our Parent Governors are elected by the current parent body of the school in question and are a vital part of our governance process.

Currently, Victoria College has a vacancy for a new Parent Governor.

The term of office is three years and Governors need to be able to attend (as a minimum) three Full Board meetings a year, although our Governors are also encouraged to participate in at least one of a number of Sub-Committees who meet every term to provide governance for specific areas of the school's strategy and operation. Governors are also warmly welcomed to attend school events.
