Dick Moore talk - Coping with your Adolescent

We are currently organising for Mr Dick Moore to attend Victoria College to talk to a number of our student year groups.

We are also delighted to be able to invite you to a parent-specific talk on 'Coping with your Adolescent' on Tuesday 31 October, 19:00 to 20:00 in the Great Hall. This invite is for all our parents, regardless of the year group your child is in.

Since November 2012, Mr Moore has been visiting schools, universities, and organisations to help raise awareness of mental health issues. In line with this he has been visiting Jersey for the last 5 year to deliver talks at schools and attended both our Mental Health conferences in 2018 and 2019 where he was very well received. Mr Moore was born and brought up in London and educated at Durham and Newcastle universities. He became an English teacher, rugby coach, boarding school housemaster and, for over twenty years, the headteacher of a co-educational day and boarding school.

He is not a doctor, psychologist, psychiatrist, or counsellor. However, he does have wide experience of working young people – not least as the father of four children! Circumstances led him to develop a passionate interest in adolescent development and emotional wellbeing.
