TWO tries from Tomasz Dobrowolski helped set Jersey RFC on their way in the under-14 Sussex League, with the Islanders claiming a comfortable victory in East Sussex.

Coming up against an unknown quantity, Jersey opted to deploy brute force to break down Heathfield in the first half, rather than using the full width of the field, and their efforts were rewarded in the final minute of the first half, as Rupert Raynes crossed over.

A long sprint from Joseph Griffiths helped set up Jersey's second after the break. Having run from deep inside his own half, Griffiths was tackled a few metres from the line but he popped the ball up to Lyle Pritchard, who did the rest.

Both teams then spent the rest of the second half much like the first – not quite able to find their rhythm and get points on the board. Then, with a few minutes left on the clock, Jersey gave their wingers a run with the ball in space. Dobrowolski obliged with two fantastic, solo tries within as many minutes, both starting from his own half.
