**Re: Grace Crocker Family Support Foundation Fun Run**

Following Mr Falle's efforts in running 2022km in 2022, we have continued our support of the Grace Crocker Family Support Foundation by engaging in their February challenge of walking, jogging or running the distance from Jersey to Southampton, with each of our year groups taking this on either as a cohort or within smaller teams. The Foundation provide financial and emotional support to families of children receiving medical care, and more information can be found [here](#).

To further support the Foundation in raising funds and increasing awareness of the support that they provide, we are once again organising a 'Fun Run' on Sunday 2<sup>nd</sup> July at 10:00. This event will encourage islanders to run, jog or walk 5.6km, the average distance Mr Falle was required to run each day in order to meet his 2022km goal. This event will take place at Les Quennevais, using an adapted version of the Jersey Park Run route. The start and finish line will be on the cycle track at Les Quennevais, just next to the cricket nets/hockey pitch.

Alternatively, participants are welcome to take part on the day without registration, though registration will enable us to plan according to expected numbers.

After the event there will be an opportunity to purchase cakes to further boost fundraising efforts, whilst students and staff will also be supporting the event by encouraging donations using donation buckets and QR codes.

We are encouraging students, staff and parents from the Victoria College community to participate and to share details of the event with friends and families. It would be fantastic if any Victoria College community members participating could wear VCJ colours of back and yellow to demonstrate our collective support of the Foundation.
