Dear Parent

Following the success of previous years, we are again running an Activity Programme for all students in the last week of the Summer Term 2023 from Monday 17 to Friday 21 July.

The aim of the week is to give our students exciting opportunities and experiences they would not otherwise have. The focus is on shared experiences and our focus this year on “Togetherness” strategic goal. Students will develop teamwork and social skills as well as gain confidence in themselves. Of course, the week is also designed to be enjoyable for all boys, whatever activity they choose- 6 days of fun with friends to celebrate a year of hard work!

This year we have been able to start expanding our off-island activity options including exciting tours of Iceland and France with the Geography and History departments. Our CCF contingent will be looking to return to their MoD visits to the UK and we have an outdoor adventure package in the UK with PGL.

This year, Activity Week is being organised by Mr Townsend so if you have any questions, please contact him as soon as possible on j.townsend@vcj.sch.je. There are a few points to note:

- The cost of off-island trips is only approximate at this stage and will depend on the final numbers travelling.
- If an activity is oversubscribed a name out of the hat system will be used for those who applied within the deadline.
- In 2022 the majority of pupils did their first-choice activity. However, the numbers meant that some second choices occasionally had to be allocated. This could happen again so please take time to consider your son’s second and third choices.
- There is the option to apply for a package for your son and a friend. Please note that in **MUST** be one entry per student only. Please confer with the other son’s parents, ensure all parties have agreed before entering **ONLY ONE** application. Any student with multiple application in their name will be allocated spaces last due to the difficulties it causes.

Please read the booklet carefully with your son and complete the online registration (information found at the end of this booklet) by Sunday 15th January.

Students who are partially available/absent

Activities Week is still part of the official school year, so all boys are required to take part. If your son is not available for the full five days of Activity Week for some reason, permission for absence must be sought from the Headteacher via the Attendance Officer.

Requests for absence must be emailed to the Attendance Officer (attendance@vcj.sch.ie) who will then process the request on your behalf and respond to you.

If your son is available for some of Activity Week there are three options:

1. He attends one of the five-day activities (no discount/refund can be given for the lost days)
2. He takes part in the free College Activities programme on the days he is available
3. He attends College when he is available for supervised self-study

This year we are continuing with our new online registration process. The original letter was sent out in November. The final deadline for applications is **Sunday 15th of January 2023**. After this point all activities will be awarded on a “name out of the hat” system when they are oversubscribed. Pupils failing to select any choice at this point will stay on the school site for the week. We will hope to then contact you with your son’s placement information and payment details in the next three weeks.
