Support in School

Year 11 tutors will be working closely with students to assist them in preparing their application. This will involve conversations about subject choices and a reminder of the various resources available to help make these decisions. Your son will be encouraged to complete draft applications using either the hard copies provided or the electronic copies which will be sent to all students via the Year 11 Team on Microsoft Teams and on Satchel.

In addition to this, each Year 11 student will be given a guidance interview with one of the Sixth Form team or a member of the Leadership Group. We will meet with your son in January or February to discuss their options and to assist them in making informed choices, with particular reference to the January mock examinations.

Students should also feel comfortable in seeking advice from subject teachers to learn more about what their A Level courses will involve. We will, at a later stage in the academic year, be setting pre-A Level work to help to prepare students for Sixth Form Studies. This work will be set during the induction days, which are held after the end of the GCSE examinations.

Application Process

As was referenced in the Information Evening, Sixth Form applications will be made electronically. Students and parents should use the link below to complete an electronic form, which when sent will act as an application to the Victoria College Sixth Form. Your son can access the online Application Form [here](#).

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We would advise students to complete a draft application in advance of attempting this online form. The deadline for applications to be submitted is Friday 9th February, and we would encourage students not to submit their application until they have received their latest mock examination results or school report.

Once the application deadline has passed, we will then process the applications and invite students and parents for an interview with the Leadership Team, consisting of the Headteacher, Deputy Headteacher and Assistant Headteachers. These interviews will enable us to discuss your son's choices as well as the progress they are making in their GCSE subjects. We will also discuss our entry criteria, which state that boys must demonstrate good academic and behavioural records.

Parental Support

As was mentioned above, students can prepare for the submission of their application by completing a draft application either electronically or on paper. You can support your son in doing this by reading through the Sixth Form Options Guide together as well as supporting them in writing their application. For example, you may challenge them to ensure they have clearly explained their reasons for wishing to pick certain subjects, as well as outlining their skills and qualities in the relevant section of the application form.

I have attached a paper copy of the application form so that your son can work on this between now and the final online submission date and will also be sharing this letter and the attachments with him via Teams.

Feedback

Finally, I would be appreciative of any feedback that you may have regarding this year's Sixth Form Open Evening. Whilst the evening format was adapted in light of industrial action, I hope that it enabled you to better understand the Sixth Form curriculum offer and application process. If you think there were things that could be improved, or that there was important information missing, please do get in touch. Your support and feedback is vital in ensuring we continue to improve and make progress here at Victoria College. Similarly, positive feedback will also be appreciated so that we can continue to do things that are well received.

I look forward to receiving your son's application and hope to see him work hard towards his GCSE examinations over the remainder of the academic year.
