**10 to Sixth Day – Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June**

As you approach the half-way stage of your GCSEs, it is important that you give time and thought to the subjects you wish to study at A Level, and the prospective paths down which they may take you.

To assist you in this process, on Thursday 22<sup>nd</sup> June you will take part in “10 to Sixth Day”. As soon as you arrive at school, for this day you will be a Sixth Former at Victoria College. You will experience A Level subjects taught in small groups, and enjoy full use of the Sixth Form Centre. If you would like to dress as a Sixth Former, instead of your normal uniform please feel free to wear a suit or smart trousers and shirt. You will also hear a presentation on the wider Sixth Form curriculum and Sixth Form expectations. The day is designed to guide you in your choice of A Level subjects and inspire you through the remainder of Year 10 and 11.

Using the information below, please select the five subjects you wish to study on the day from the option blocks, selecting one subject per column. You will follow a three A Level programme in Year 12, but we wanted to provide you with the opportunity to learn more about four subjects during 10 to Sixth Day. Your parents will receive a letter containing the online link for you to select your options. Please submit your choices by Friday 26<sup>th</sup> May. Some choices are combined options, such as history / politics, to allow the relevant department to explain both subjects to you where you be unsure which to pick but do not wish to attend both separately.

The subjects you choose could be ones you have never taken before, or perhaps you may wish to understand how the delivery of subjects you know well will differ in the Sixth Form.

Sixth Form will be a wonderfully exciting time in your life; you will learn a great deal and start on a path that will determine the person you become. I hope you are excited about the chance to experience life in the Sixth Form and that you grab the opportunity to see for yourself what is possible.
