

Do you have your sights set on rich, college level education?

If so, we look forward to welcoming you to our Sixth Form.

APPLY TODAY

To enter the Sixth Form at Victoria College, you will need a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 4.8 and a minimum of Grade 4 in both English and Mathematics GCSE, which we will expect you to improve and upgrade to a Grade 5 by November.

If you would like to access three full A level subjects, you will also need a minimum GPA of 5.5 at GCSE.

Please note that certain subjects have specific entry requirements. Individual cases may be considered on their merit by the Head of Sixth Form after consultation with Heads of Department.

All prospective Sixth Formers have an interview with the Headteacher and Head of Sixth Form before they can join. Where a candidate is new to Victoria College, a satisfactory reference will be required from their current school.

Students who are already at Victoria College will need to show a good record of good behaviour, attendance and a positive attitude to his studies - or a genuine undertaking to address any issues raised at interview before a conditional offer of a place will be made.

You can register for entry into Sixth Form at Victoria College, by completing this form between Tuesday 15th November 2022 and Friday 10th February 2023.

Entry Criteria

- Grade point average of 4.8 minimum required for entry in to Sixth Form, from a minimum of 8 GCSE subjects
- Those between 4.8 and 5.5 considered on individual merit, with possible direction towards appropriate subject combinations (including vocational at consortium schools)
- Grade point average of 5.5 at GCSE recommended for a three A Level programme
- Grade 4 in both English (Literature OR Language) and Mathematics GCSE
- N.B. Separate entry requirements exist for some subjects (e.g. A Level Mathematics) full details in the subject options guide
- Good behavioural record
