<u>PJ Thomson</u> is a lecturer in Art & Design at Highlands College, specialising in printmaking, ceramics and textiles.

Starting out at Jersey Potteries working as a ceramics decorator, he then worked in the care sector, for Les Amis for 15 years. Making a switch, he then completed his Foundation certificate in Art and Design at Highlands and went on to obtain a 1st class degree in Textile Design for Fashion and Interiors.

As well as lecturing full time, PJ has featured in several exhibitions at CGA galleries, JAC, Jane James and last year he won the prestigious JJ Fox Open Art Competition.

Anna is the Education Officer at <u>ArtHouse Jersey</u>, whose mission it is to provide creative opportunities for young people in Jersey.

She is a mixed media artist working with sustainable and recycled materials. She received a (BA) Fine Art degree from Falmouth College of Arts focussing on Institutional Critique. On returning to Jersey she has worked simultaneously as an artist, educator and youth worker. More recently she has gained a Masters in Youth Work, Community Learning & Development, focussing on Environmental Rights.

Anna has continued to develop her own practice and has supported a range of ArtHouse Jersey community projects such as Skipton Big Ideas, Where Waste Meets Design, Forget Me Knots and Paper Dialogues.
