Those seeking to depart on overseas holidays at the end of term, please be aware that <u>Saturday</u>, <u>22nd July</u>, is a day after the end of the summer term. Accommodation

Pupils will stay at Hotel Viking in multi-bed rooms; we will endeavour to allocate rooms based on year groups and, if possible, friendship groups. However, please be aware that this might not always be possible. Staff will be staying in the same accommodation block with a current ratio of seven pupils to one staff member.

We have opted for a full board option, with the hotel kindly providing packed lunches. Based on information from our tour operated and supported by staff members who have previously used this hotel, these are good quality packed lunches, and closer to the time, we will collect dietary requirements and needs. Pupils are welcome to purchase their own lunches; however, all food is included in the trip price.

Cost

The all-inclusive cost, based on an attendance of 30 students, will be no more than £1450 per pupil, payable with an initial non-refundable deposit of £100 and three instalments of £450.

£100 – Initial non–refundable deposit £450 – Due Monday 9th January £450 – Due Monday 6th March £450 – Due Wednesday 10th May Payment can be made in full at any time during this period. Late joining via full payment after 10th May might incur an increased cost due to flight and accommodation availability.
