## <u>Open Cross-Country Competition – Wednesday 21 February 2024</u> <u>1.30pm Start - Les Quennevais Playing Fields</u>

We would like to offer your son the opportunity to take part in the Primary schools Open Cross-Country Competition. This wonderful event has been very successful over the last few years, attracting up to 1000 entries of varying standards from the Jersey Primary Schools. The children will run a distance of around 1400m.

The competition will start at 1.30pm and we will be transporting your son to the event. If you would like your son brought back to school for the end of the day, we will endeavor to ensure that he is back on time, however, please be aware that if there are any traffic delays it may be slightly after 3pm. If you are planning to come along to spectate you are permitted to take your son with you at the end. We will also require a few parents to help supervise the boys while at the venue. You will need to be at Les Quennevais at 2.10pm at the latest, as the coach will be departing no later than 2.15pm.

## Kit required:

Please be advised that as we are booking transport no late entries will be accepted. It is also essential that if your son needs to pull out of the event due to injury or illness that as much notice as possible is given.

Please send your son in with a packed lunch in a disposable bag as they will be having lunch earlier than usual.
