

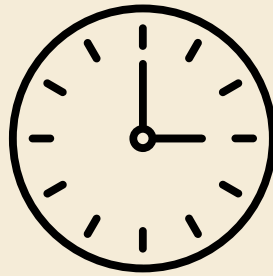

End of Day Arrangements!



IN AN EFFORT TO MAKE PICK-UP AS ORDERLY AND SAFE AS POSSIBLE WE ASK THAT PARENTS RESPECT THE FOLLOWING RULES AT ALL TIMES

- DO NOT PARK AT THE SIDE OF THE ROAD IN RESIDENTIAL AREAS OR LEAVE YOUR CAR UNATTENDED IN THE PICK-UP LOOP.
- KEEP IT MOVING: IF YOUR CHILD IS NOT AT THE GATE ON YOUR ARRIVAL YOU WILL BE ASKED TO DRIVE AROUND THE LOOP, PLEASE DO THIS WITHOUT DISCUSSION.

The VCP Digital Safety Story Competition: A Modern Tale Twist!

HOW TO BUILD YOUR STORY

- 1. Pick a Traditional Tale.**
Choose a classic story you love and get ready to give it a modern technology twist.
- 2. Add Modern Tech.**
Your story must include at least one piece of modern technology, like a smartphone, a tablet, or a computer.
- 3. Problem + Safe Solution.**
Show your characters facing a modern technology danger and, most importantly, finding a safe way to solve it.
- 4. End with a Moral.**
Every great safety story needs a clear lesson at the end about how to stay safe in the digital world.

NEED AN IDEA?
EXAMPLE: Aladdin and the Magical AI App.
Think about how Aladdin might use a smart app instead of a lamp—what digital dangers might he find, and how would he stay safe?

THE COMPETITION RULES

- ONE PAGE MAXIMUM.** Keep your story exciting and concise; it must fit onto a single page.
- CREATIVE PRESENTATION.** The judges are looking for well-written stories that are presented neatly and creatively.
- THE DIGITAL LINK.** Make sure there is a very clear connection between your traditional tale and the modern technology danger you choose.

Hand your finished masterpiece to **MR DELAHUNTY** by this date to be entered into the competition.

STAGE 1 JUDGING. All entries will first be judged by the Heads of Houses.
